



Session 1: Mrs.Arпита Vaidya

Topic: Identification of Research Problem

A research problem is a question that a researcher wants to answer or a problem that a researcher wants to solve. Identification and formulation of a research problem is the first step of the research process. It is believed that selection of a good research problem is a discovery in itself.

SOURCES OF RESEARCH PROBLEM 1: Personal Experiences 2 Practical Experience 3. Critical Appraisal of Literature 4. Previous Research 5. Existing Theories 6. Consumer Feedback 7. Performance improvement 8. Social issues 9. Brainstorming

Characteristic of Research Problem

Any research is a difficult task to achieve and research needs to do a great effort. Selection of research topic is the first step to success.

1. Research topic must be very clear and easy to understand. It should not distract people.
2. If a topic is well define is the only way to successful research. The topic should not create doubt and double impression.

Session 2: Mr.Virendra Jain

Topic: Writing objectives and hypothesis

A hypothesis is a conjectural statement of the relation between two or more variables.

Hypothesis is a tentative prediction or explanation of the relationship between two variables. It implies that there is a systematic relationship between an independent and a dependent variable. For example, dietary compliance will be

greater in diabetic patients receiving diet instruction in small groups than in diabetic patients receiving individualized diet instructions

Research Objective: A research objective is a clear, concise, declarative statement, which provides direction to investigate the variables. Generally research objective focus on the ways to measure the variables, such as to identify or describe them

CHARACTERISTICS OF RESEARCH OBJECTIVES: Research objectives is a concrete statement describing what the research is trying to achieve. A well-worded objective will be SMART, i.e Specific, Measurable, Attainable, Realistic, & Time-bound.® Research objective should be Relevant, Feasible, Logical, Observable, Unequivocal& Measurable



Session 3: Mr.TrilokSompura

Topic: Variables in Research and Assumptions

Variables is something that is variable changes quite often, and there usually seems to be no fixed pattern to these changes.

The dependent variable is the variable a researcher is interested in. The changes to the dependent variable are what the researcher is trying to measure with all their fancy techniques.

An independent variable is a variable believed to affect the dependent variable. This is the variable that you, the researcher, will manipulate to see if it makes the dependent variable change.

An assumption is a realistic expectation which is something that we believe to be true. However, no adequate evidence exists to support this belief. In other words, an assumption is an act of faith which does not have empirical evidence to support.

Assumptions are statements that are taken for granted or are considered true, even though they have not been scientifically tested. Assumptions are principles those are accepted as being true based on logic or reasons, but without proof or verification.

USES OF ASSUMPTION IN RESEARCH: Research is built upon assumptions since a foundation is needed to move forward. One must assume something to discover something. Assumptions listed in research paper may be good sources of the research topics. Assumptions provide basis to conduct of the research study.



Session 4: Mrs.Dhara Vyas

Topic: Development of conceptual framework

Conceptual framework represent ways of thinking about a problem. It deals with abstractions (concepts) that are assembled by virtue of relevance to a common theme.

Conceptual frameworks serve as the springboard for theory development. Conceptual framework shows the relationship of the stated hypotheses with central factors or key concepts

Purposes 1. Conceptual Framework 2. Keep research on track 3. Provides clear links from the literature to the research goals and questions 4. Helps the researcher to see clearly the variables of the study

Session 5: Mr.VipinPatidar

Topic: Review of literature

A literature review is a search and evaluation of the available literature in your given subject or chosen topic area. It documents the state of the art with respect to the subject or topic you are writing about.

A literature review has four main objectives:

- It surveys the literature in your chosen area of study
- It synthesises the information in that literature into a summary
- It critically analyses the information gathered by identifying gaps in current knowledge; by showing limitations of theories and points of view; and by formulating areas for further research and reviewing areas of controversy
- It presents the literature in an organised way

A literature review is an evaluative report of information found in the literature related to your selected area of study. The review should describe, summarise, evaluate and clarify this literature. It should give a theoretical base for the research and help you (the author) determine the nature of your research. Works which are irrelevant should be discarded and those which are peripheral should be looked at critically.



Session 6: Ms.NehaParmar

Topic: Research approach and design

The systematic method consisting of enunciating the problem, formulating a hypothesis, collecting the facts or data, analysing the facts and reaching a certain conclusion either in the form of solution towards the concerned problem or in certain generalisations for some theoretical formulation.


A research design is the framework or guide used for the planning, implementation, and analysis of a study. It is the plan for answering the research question or hypothesis. Different types of questions or hypotheses demand different types of research designs, so it is important to have a broad preparation and understanding of the different types of research designs available. Research designs are most often classified as either quantitative or qualitative. However, it is becoming more common for investigators to combine, or mix, multiple quantitative and/or qualitative designs in the same study.

Session 7: Ms.Minaz Vohra

Topic :Research Methodology and Sampling

The process of selecting a number of individuals for a study in such a way that the individuals represent the larger group from which they were selected.

Important issues: Representation: the extent to which the sample is representative of the population Generalization: The extent to which the results of the study can be reasonably extended from the sample to the population Sampling error: The chance occurrence that a randomly selected sample is not representative of the population due to errors inherent in the sampling technique



Session 8: Ms.Sanjana Bhatia

Topic: Analysis and Interpretation in Nursing Research

It is the process of organizing data into logical, sequential and meaningful categories and classifications to make them amenable to study and interpretation.

1. Textual: Statements with numerals or numbers that serve as supplements to tabular presentation
2. Tabular: A systematic arrangement of related idea in which classes of numerical facts or data are given each row and their subclasses are given each a column in order to present the relationships of the sets or numerical facts or data in a definite, compact and understandable form

3. Graphical – (a chart representing the quantitative variations or changes of variables in pictorial or diagrammatic form)

The analysis, regardless of whether the data is qualitative or quantitative, may:

1. Describe and summarize the data.
2. Identify relationships between variables.
3. Compare variables.
4. Identify the difference between variables.
5. Forecast outcomes.



Session 9: Mr. Nickson Das

Topic: Dissemination of research findings

- The completion of research study is only the beginning of the nurse investigator's work. The value of the research will never be fully appreciated unless it is shared.
- Dissemination of research can be invigorating, particularly when the investigator has the opportunity to share the richness of the data.

Types:

- Active dissemination : Tailoring of research findings to a target audience using a dynamic flow of information

- Passive dissemination : It is a form communication such as publication in academic journal


