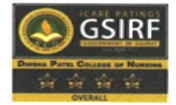




PROGRAMME OUTCOME OF BASIC B.SC. NURSING

On completion of the four year B.Sc. Nursing program the graduates will be able to:

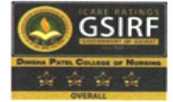
- P01. Exhibit understanding of life style and other factors, which affect health of individuals and groups.

On Completion of the two year M.Sc Nursing programme, the graduate will be able to:-

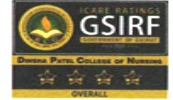
- P01. Utilize/apply the concepts, theories and principles of nursing science
