- Well constructed hospital and Physiotherapy centre with 2 floors, having administrative block, more than 20 OPD rooms, Pharmacy Department, Laboratory area, 7 Operation theaters and five huge wards at Santram Eye Hospital.
- Santram Physiotherapy centre consist of cerebral palsy department,
- Followed by the visit to MPUH – Kidney Hospital, Big institute for treated diseases related renal.
- Kidney hospital consist administrative block, various IPD rooms, ICU, Radiological departments, cafeteria, Operation theatre and big Dialysis department.

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- Than we have seen show at planetarium which was about life on moon and effect of sun on earth. This was very nice and informative.

- Ayurvedic hospital has its own pharmacy department and garden for medicine plants. They prepare Ayurvedic medicine by their own.
- Lastly at Ayurvedic campus we visited Ayurvedic college with good infrastructure consist of various class room, big Library, staff room etc.

- Morning 10am there was a visit to Old Age Home- Pij

Brief about old age Home-

- 2 floor building with total 20 rooms and 2 dormitories with capacity of 60-80 older people. There are total 40 older people with staff. They do various activities like bhajan, morning walk , celebration of festivals etc. They do Lunch at 11 am and dinner at 7pm and after 9pm they can go for sleep.
- After briefing the old age home by warden we left to talk with older people. Older people shared their view, problems, facilities provided to them, daily schedule etc with visitors and vice versa.
- Visitors wishes to listen bhajan and older people wishes swedish song. After sharing view by visitors we left from old age home at 12.15pm. Visit was very helpful and informative.



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- In the evening dinner was hosted by Mrs. Arpita Vaidhya for Faculty and students went to MC Donald.

Day: 13

- The day started with lecture on Health care delivery system in Sweden and Life style disease by Ms. Ase Bygrene .
- There was good bye ceremony presided by chairman and secretary.
- There was concluding comments from director Dr. B.H.Shelat and Ms. Cherlotta And it was considered as a very successful programme.

CONCLUSION:

- These fourth year exchange programme started with very warm and friendly greetings.
